Rules and Regulations

General Information

- 1. All South Dakota Fishing and Boating regulations will be followed.
- 2. Must have valid South Dakota Fishing License
- 3. This is an individual event, not a team event. The heaviest single fish in all categories will determine the winner.
- 4. The weigh-in will take place at the North Point Fish Cleaning Station.
- 5. Grand prize winner and other award winners for heaviest single weight fish categories will be announced at the weigh in station.
- 6. Children under 16 may not need a fishing license but could affect the total limit for your boat. Check with South Dakota DNR for youth rules and regulations.

Launching Rules

- 1. Pre-registration serves as check-in for the event. You must be registered prior to 7 am the day of the event to be eligible for prizes. You will **not** need to check in at the boat ramp.
- 2. A 7 am honor system start time will apply. Any time after 7 am fish can legally be counted anywhere below or above Fort Randall Dam.
- 3. All fishermen wanting to weigh fish are required to be at North Point Fish Cleaning Station by 4 pm for weigh-in. The scales will close at 4:30 pm. A pickup and go meal will be given out at the weigh in.
